REGULATIONS

Judging will be according to NBS rules.

Entries must be made on an official entry form and handed to the show secretary at the show between 8.30 am and 11.30am

Staging must be completed and all surplus plant material, packing material etc. removed by 11.45am when judging will commence.

Boards will be provided for the cut bloom classes, but exhibitors may use their own which must comply with NBS rules. Adhesive labels must not be stuck on the boards; Exhibitors must use the NBS name sheets provided.

No unauthorised person will be admitted into the hall whilst judging is in progress.

Judges' decision is final; any protest must be lodged in writing with the Show Secretary by 2.30pm

There will be no limit to the number of entries and awards won by any exhibitor in any class

With exception to Class 12, plants in the Pot Plant Classes should not be "staged for effect" they will be judged as individual Pot Plants.

Plants in the Pot Plant Classes may be raised up off the staging provided, using unobtrusive supporting objects, but only to ensure that the foliage can rest safely clear of the staging or to balance the exhibit

No external embellishments such as cloth around the pots will be permitted.

All Exhibits must carry an Exhibitors Card, and must be correctly named.
If unknown, this must be stated "UNKNOWN"

Any plant showing disease or pest infestation will be removed from the show.

The organisers of the show will make careful arrangements for the protection of all exhibits but cannot be answerable or responsible for any loss or damage to exhibits.

No exhibit or part-exhibit may be removed without authority from the show secretary until 4pm.

All trophies are PERPETUAL and must be returned to the Show Secretary 14 days before the next annual show.

Class No	Open Classes for Current NBS Members Only
1	Six Cut Blooms of Tuberous Double Begonias
2	Three Cut Blooms of Tuberous Double Begonias
3	One Cut Bloom of Tuberous Double Begonia
4	Three Pots of Tuberous Double Begonias
5	Three Pots of Tuberous Double Begonias. Restricted. Plants to be grown in pots of diameter no greater than 18cm (7in) or of volume no greater than 3L. Plants to be grown as one main stem, and side shoots to be clearly visible above the compost.
6	One Pot of Tuberous Double Begonias. Restricted. To be grown as in Class 5
7	One Pot of Tuberous Double Begonia
8	One Pot and 1 Cut Bloom of Tuberous Double Begonia Must be the same variety
9	One Hanging container of Begonias
10	Three Pots of Begonias other than tuberous double
11	One Pot of Begonia other than tuberous double
12	Group of Begonias in pots. No hanging containers or any other plant material will be permitted. To be staged for effect. A bench space of 1.2m wide by 1.2m deep, will be provided. Exhibitors may provide their own tiering. One or two exhibitors can enter jointly.
13	One pot of Multiflora Begonia to be grown in a pot, One tuber per pot.

An **Intermediate** exhibitor must be a current member of the NBS who has not won more than 5 first prizes at intermediate and/ or open classes at NBS shows prior to the current season.

14	Two Pots of Tuberous Double Begonias
15	Three Cut Blooms of Tuberous Double Begonias
16	One Cut Bloom of Tuberous Double Begonia

A **Novice** is open to anyone who has not won more than 5 first prizes at any NBS shows prior to the current season.

17	One Pot of Tuberous Double Begonias
18	Three Cut Blooms of Tuberous Double Begonias
19	One Cut Bloom of Tuberous Double Begonia
20	One Pot of Begonia other than tuberous double
21	One pot of Multiflora Begonia to be grown in a pot. One tuber per pot.

The Taylor Batty Trophy and Silver Card will be awarded to the Best Exhibit in the show.

The Joe Mallon Trophy and Silver Card will be awarded to the winner of Class 1

The Colin Whewell Trophy and Silver Card will be awarded to the winner of Class 4

The Jeff Rhodes Trophy and Silver Card will be awarded to the winner of Class10

The NBS Bronze medal and rosette will be awarded to the best pot of begonia in the show

The NBS Bronze medal and rosette will be awarded to the best cut bloom in the show
